Oviva voted as the top company out of 100 nominations

The selection committee of the TTG50 was chaired by Falk Müller-Veerse of Bryan Garnier & Co, Janke Dittmer of Gilde Healthcare and Remy de Tonnac of ETF Partners, and supplemented by 49 additional growth investors. They assessed Oviva and all other companies based on achievement, impact, and momentum. Janke Dittmer is convinced of Oviva's approach: “Oviva is the deserved winner of the Tech Tour Growth Award 2022 for Health. Out of 100 nominations, 15 health companies were selected by the investor jury to present at the Tech Tour Growth50 event. Oviva was voted the top company, as it demonstrated impressive scale and impact on patients' lives across key European countries. Yet, the best seems still to come for this European digital health role model.”

Growth journey continues

Oviva is continuing its growth journey, pursuing the goal to employ 800 people by the end of 2022 and delivering care for hundreds of thousands of patients.
